Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

The Snyder parcel is 135 acres of undeveloped wetland habitat on the Gustavus forelands. The parcel is used by waterfowl and shorebirds and provides important habitat for sandhill cranes. It adjoins the Dude Creek Critical Habitat Area (CHA), designated for the protection of sandhill crane habitat, and is of interest to the Alaska Department of Fish and Game as a potential addition to the CHA. This will have a \$104.0 match (25%) provided by The Nature Conservancy.
