Project Description/Justification:

Advertising along the state's main highways is restricted by Alaska Statute 19.25.105. In the lower 48 states, standard signs were developed to limit the visual "pollution" of large billboards and neon signs while directing travelers to restaurants, lodging, fuel, attractions, etc. In some cases, charges are assessed for including a specific business name on the sign.

We will notify illegal sign owners of this new program and that they must remove their existing signs.
