FY2005 - \$845,000; FY2004 - \$2,450,000; FY2003 - \$7,300,000.

**Project Description/Justification:**

Funds will be used to replace the existing grader at St. George that is in very poor condition and breaks down frequently. Because the St. George Airport Improvements project will pave 5000' runway, taxiway and apron, maintenance requirements will increase significantly. The Chenega Bay Airport requires a new loader with snowblower to keep up with required runway maintenance. Funds will also be used for various airport equipment as needs are identified and as funding allows.
