Project Description/Justification:

The building that houses the Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services, as well as the City's Finance offices, Administration offices, Library and Council Chamber is grossly inadequate for its current use, does not meet code requirements, and is not compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

A new Public Safety Building will provide office and operational space for the following agencies: Fire, Police, jail, dispatch, EOC, the Alaska Court System, the Alaska Children's Services, and the Alaska State Troopers.

\$350,000 is needed for the preliminary architectural design. The total project cost is estimated to be \$15 million. It is anticipated that 50 to 75% of the full cost will come from grants, with the remainder coming from loan or bond propositions.
