**Project Description/Justification:**

Section 5309 provides grants to governmental entities for the purchase of buses and bus-related items. And because the Alaska Mobility Coalition (AMC) is a private nonprofit organization, they are unable to apply for the funding. The AMC has requested that DOT&PF administer this funding in conjunction with the annual coordinated transportation grant program. These funds will be included with the AMC funding the department presently administers for public transportation. No state match is required to accept these funds. Match will be provided by the transportation providers who receive the vehicles.
