## **Project Description/Justification:**

This project will construct projects scheduled in the last five years of a ten-year airfield improvement program committed to by the FAA in Letter of Intent (LOI) AAL-98-1, dated November 10, 1998. Projects still to be constructed include B Concourse, North Taxilane, Remote Overnight (RON) Parking Apron and South Terminal, A Concourse Aprons. B Concourse, North Taxilane is the last remaining taxilane to the new C Concourse to be brought up to current airport and FAA standards. Construction will remove a portion of the oldest asphalt pavement and replace some of the weakest structural section supporting heavy jet aircraft on the airport. Construction will also complete taxilane centerline lighting constructed in earlier phases of LOI 1. The RON Parking Apron will alleviate the over-night aircraft parking space shortage caused by the loss of spaces during construction of the new C Concourse. South Terminal Concourse A Apron construction will replace individual concrete hardstands at each heavy jet gate around Concourse A with a continuous concrete apron and will be sited to serve new gate configurations resulting from construction of C Concourse.
