Project Description/Justification:

This road is essential to the development and utilization of the soon to be constructed boat harbor at Akutan. The Corp of Engineers (COE) has recently confirmed the harbor location site and most likely harbor construction schedule. It is critical for safety, economic, health, and quality of life concerns that the harbor access road be completed no later than, and ideally before, the harbor construction. Completion of the road prior to harbor construction, although not absolutely essential, would facilitate the harbor construction effort.
