Rehabilitate and widen the 15.5 mile gravel surface haul road connecting Lower Cook Inlet at Williamsport with the Interior of Southwest Alaska at Illiama Lake. Include drainage improvements, culvert installation, replacement, clearing and grubbing. Replace or repair two bridges: Timberline Creek bridge#1321 and Four mile Creek Bridge #1235. Construct parking/staging areas at each end of the road. Improve the barge landing facility including dredging, if required. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.
