Project Description/Justification:

The existing dirt floors have uneven work surfaces which affects safety in the workplace. There are environmental concerns due to possible seepage of industrial contaminants into the soil. New concrete floors would improve safety by providing even surfaces with more stable footing, improve environmental conditions and would handle heavier equipment and ease building maintenance by reducing mud and dust.
