#### **Key Component Challenges**

Provide adequate administrative support to programs to continue receiving audits that do not contain findings which need to be addressed.

Ensure program policies and regulations are reflective of current business practices and law.

Ensure that the division's programs for Alaskans with disabilities are current with ever changing information technology and computer-based information systems.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2008

While program costs continue to increase, the division will work with the State Independent Living Council, the Governor's Committee on Employment and Rehabilitation of People with Disabilities, Workforce Investment Partners, and the Mental Health Board to improve services to people with disabilities and establish which services receive priority.

#### Major Component Accomplishments in 2006

Assisted in the passage of House Bill 357 which updated the terminology in various State statutes by making it more consistent with and reflective of the disability community's goals and agenda.

In partnership with the Governor's Committee on Employment and Rehabilitation of People with Disabilities completed the vocational rehabilitation 2007 State Plan amendments which were approved by the division's federal parent agency, the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA).

The division partnered with 12 Alaska Tribal vocational rehabilitation partners in completing an Interagency Agreement to cooperate, coordinate and collaborate in providing vocational opportunities for Alaskans with disabilities.

Submitted all federal financial and program reports on time and met or exceeded all federal standards and indicators.

During 2005-2006 the RSA closed their regional offices and began administering programs from Washington DC. A State Monitoring and Program Improvement team has been assigned to Alaska. The State liaison for the team visited Alaska in May and new relationships have been formed. The division is scheduled for a comprehensive review in 2008.

Provided internship opportunities to special education teachers to strengthen our Youth Transition services.
