## Component: Batterers Intervention Program

### Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide for the planning and coordination of services to domestic violence offenders, in order to change the offenders' violent behavior.

### Core Services

- Develop, implement, maintain, and monitor community and prison-based batterers' intervention programs.
- Develop and implement a standardized data collection system for state-approved batterers' intervention programs.
- Receive and dispense state money by awarding grants and contracts to qualified local community entities for batterers' intervention programs.
- Oversee and audit all state-approved batterers' intervention programs.
- Provide fiscal and technical assistance to batterers' intervention programs.

There is a need for further development of collaborative systems between the courts, batterer programs, and victim services. Coordination between agencies closes the gaps that offenders use to circumvent the system and provides the most effective process to change offenders' behavior.

CDVSA is in the process of reviewing the criteria and delivery systems for batterer's programs.

### Major Component Accomplishments in 2006

CDVSA implemented the Batterer Intervention Program work group in order to review the various aspects of providing batterer program services.
