Project Description/Justification:

Advanced Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) technology exists that could enable certain transit routes to significantly reduce travel time (up to 30%) which should significantly increase ridership, especially if used in combination with an increase in frequency (as recommended in the municipalities long range transportation plan). The HPTC Prototype Plan is intended to develop an implementation plan for one corridor in the Anchorage Bowl in order to test and evaluate this new technology prior to adoption systemwide.
