Project Description/Justification:

Funding is requested for a roof replacement project for the Archives Office Building in Juneau. The Archives and Records Center building was constructed in 1974. It currently has the original metal roof with a styrofoam spray overlay. The facility continues to have multiple roof leaks, causing water infiltration to the occupants and potential damage to valuable archived documents. Wet conditions, if not actively identified and handled, can also lead to environmental health hazards (mold). Complete replacement of the roof is required to prevent catastrophic failure.
