\$1,200.0 Underground Fuel Piping and Tank Replacement

The existing fuel system at this facility is constructed of single wall tanks and piping and is subject to a catastrophic failure and release of fuel into the ground. The evaluation for this system in the Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plan (SPCC) has identified the need for a replacement system. This funding will implement the design and replacement for prevention of ground/groundwater contamination from this system.
