Contribution to Department's Mission

The mission of the Interior-Aleutians Campus is to integrate lifelong educational opportunities with rural Alaska and Alaska Native communities, cultures and ways of life.

Core Services

The Interior-Aleutians Campus (I-AC) serves Alaska's Interior region, an area larger than France, and extends its service area to the Aleutians, a total area of about 200,000 square miles. With the largest land base of any rural campus, the area served by I-AC includes eleven separate school districts; several state government service areas; and three regional Native corporations. This campus also serves an Alaska Native population that is culturally and linguistically very diverse.

Through its six rural education centers, the Interior-Aleutians Campus offers a variety of degree and non-degree educational opportunities including Certificate and AAS degrees in Tribal Management, Construction Trades Technology, and Rural Human Services.
