**Project Description/Justification:**

The Court System received \$4,226.0 in capital budget appropriations during the FY00 - FY09 timeframe to address deferred maintenance.

This request for \$2,500.0 will address a few more of the Court System's most urgent and critical deferred maintenance needs. At the Ketchikan Court and Office Building, deficiencies in the current heating/cooling system, interior surface finishes and lighting systems will be addressed. At the Anchorage Boney Courthouse, some portion of the outdated and failing mechanical systems in the penthouse will be replaced.
