Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Improvements include construction of "missing links" in the pedestrian facility network and rehabilitation of existing sidewalks and trails. If state grant funding is provided construction is expected to start in 2010. Many pedestrian facilities in Anchorage are deteriorating. There are also many "missing links" in the sidewalk/trail/pathway system. In four of the last five years, state grants have funded more than 40 projects areawide. A detailed list of 2010 projects is under development.

Construction is expected to start in 2010 on many projects with most expenditures in 2010 and 2011.
