Replace 27 iMacs in school computer lab (2.66 GHz, 2GB Ram, Applecare protection plan)

Note: On November 11, 2008, the Chugach Optional Community Assembly approved the expenditure of \$10,000 to match legislative funding for refreshing the student laptops and computer lab at Chugach Optional.

### Benefits if Project is Funded

Computer skills (computer awareness, keyboarding, word processing, multi-media tools) are taught in the computer lab to classes throughout the day. Students use computer skills taught to the whole group in the lab when working in their classrooms on laptops, effectively integrating technology throughout the curriculum and providing intervention when necessary. Currently, the five-year old machines are experiencing frequent crashes and long log-in times. The memory is insufficient to support Mac OS X 10.7 and updated software. Students and teachers will not grow in their integration of technology, but instead move away from integrating technology in their studies as the tools become more and more outdated.
