The existing systems have since been discontinued and there is no local support to maintain these systems. The existing Systems does not allow for integration with the phone systems installed in the building. Current educational specifications require the intercom system be connected with the building's exterior phone systems. This requirement increases the ability for the teacher to communicate outside the building in case of emergency without the need to contact the main administration area. These current systems require additional maintenance man hours to maintain. The District's technicians are certified to service system from an alternative manufacturer (Dukane). These Dukane systems have the ability to connect to the buildings exterior phone system.
