Adding this feature to the Chugiak Senior Center eliminates 1) potentially serious, life-threatening exposure to cold for facility users, many of whom are physically fragile and highly susceptible to the dangers of the Alaskan cold, and 2) improves air quality around the Chugiak Senior Center by reducing the length of infine time of particul users.
