Explanation of Other Funds:

KISA is currently able to contribute this amount that comes from general funds and monies raised in shooting events.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The funding obtained will go directly to the purchase, shipment, installation, and instruction of a new target retrieval system. This will replace the original 25 year old system we currently have that has passed its useful life and is in a constant state of needing repairs. This project is simply a replacement of a much needed (and much used) target retrieval system that can be accomplished in two phases. The first being the removal of the old system when the new one arrives and the second phase being the installation of the new system.

Both the public and KISA members will benefit from this by having a local, safe, reliable, and proper place to shoot. Recently the issue of unsafe, informal shooting being done off the sides of the road (often having rounds go out into the ocean and trails that threatened boaters and hikers) has commanded efforts among the Kodiak City, Borough, Police Department, State Troopers, Coast Guard, and KISA to ensure the population know about and use designated shooting areas. KISA has re-doubled their efforts through PSA's and brochures to bring awareness to the public indoor range. Currently, we can only manage to keep seven or eight of the ten shooting lanes operational at any given time. Having to use parts from the lines that are down to keep others running. The target retrieval system is the backbone of KISA's shooting programs and without a reliable system; shooters become frustrated and stop returning.

A previous attempt of trying to raise the needed funding to replace the system were letters sent out by KISA advertising "selling" a lane to a sponsor but that attempt did not work.

We are extremely fortunate in the volunteers we have who donate their electronic expertise to keep what functioning lanes we do have up and running. Without them, we might only have four or five lanes that can be used. By acquiring a new target retrieval system, the Kodiak Island Sportsman's Association will be able to continue to provide the community of Kodiak and its surrounding villages, the Coast Guard and other Law Enforcement agencies an improved, safe, and reliable

place to shoot.

The Board of the Kodiak Island Sportsman's Association is all volunteers participate in running our shooting programs, matches, educational sessions, range clean-up details, and other work parties who help keep the range up and running are also volunteers. KISA has been very fortunate in the quality of those who help, as without them, the range would have fallen into total disrepair long ago. This indoor range is an established part of the Kodiak community and benefits the public by providing a safe place to shoot all year around. If we can no longer provide this, those shooters who have been using the indoor range will be adding to the problem of unauthorized firearm use in unsafe, make-shift ranges on the side of the road. This puts the community (hikers, boaters and recreational beach goers) at an unnecessary risk of being hit by stray gunfire. KISA is doing everything possible to curb these make-shift ranges and by offering a fully functional indoor shooting range, in addition to more public education, Kodiak residents will continue to have a safe, appropriate place to shoot.

Detailed project Description:

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Top-Level Project timeline:

Once funding is granted, KISA will place the order for the Meggitt Target System (included in additional backup). When the units arrive, we will have to close the range down, and our volunteers will remove and properly dispose of the old system and with the assistance of a Meggitt representative (who is part of the installation agreement) will install and test the new system. We estimate three to four weeks shipping time and one week for removal and installation and testing of the new system. When the system is up and running at 100%, the range will re-open to the public. We already have the entire Board and an additional 6 volunteer range officers ready to help with the removal and installation/training of the new system.

Detailed project funding date:

This is a straight forward project in that once funding is received, the system will be purchased and installed once it arrives. The requested cost includes shipping and assistance with installation. Removal and disposal of the old system will be done by members as will most of the installation.

What entity will be responsible for the ongoing maintenance and operations of this project once it's complete?

The Kodiak Island Sportsman's Association (KISA) Board of Directors and member volunteers/ Range Officers will provide all maintenance and operation of this system. Training specific to this system will be conducted for all Range Officers and the Chief Range Officer will hold the primary responsibility to ensure all volunteers are versed in the operation and basic maintenance of the system.


