Brief Project Description:

The proposed work will provide a pedestrian activated crossing flasher system and add a raised crosswalk across the north side of LaTouche Street. This project will increase the use of the pedestrian warning lights to an as-required basis rather than just for school times, making pedestrians more visible to drivers by elevating them above the level of the pavement.
