Brief Project Description:

Rehabilitation / completion of the Atka Public Safety / Fire Station Building. Work will include rehabilitation of building electrical system, connection to water and sewer, excess energy recovery project, flooring, improving energy efficiency of the building, insulation, replacement of faulty doors and windows and cosmetic improvements.

Funding Plan:**Total Cost of Project: \$265,000***There is no other funding needed***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The building was initially constructed in 1982 as a garage to house a fire truck. An addition was added in 1994 to provide space for a used ambulance. The VPSO later moved his office into the building and a rudimentary holding cell was added to the garage. The electrical system was disconnected in 2007 because of fear of fire, and the VPSO moved operations into his home. There is no water and sewer to the facility.

This funding will provide enough to renovate the entire facility to add electricity, water and sewer, heat, improve holding cell facilities, and make the building usable as more than a unheated garage for fire and emergency equipment. Energy efficiency and conservation measures will be utilized.

April - August 2011 - Renovation and Installation
