Soldotna Little League - Capital Improvements to Bring City Water into Complex and Build Proper Bathrooms

Brief Project Description:

To bring city water into the Little League Complex. To build proper restrooms.

Funding Plan:**Total Cost of Project: \$32,700***There is no other funding needed***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

This project is to bring city water into the Soldotna Little League complex and to construct restroom facilities, so that the use of porta potties can be discontinued. This will reduce the health risks of contracting E-COIL-HEPITIOUS, ect. The porta potty company doesn't provide hand sanitizers which causes a major health issue. The water will be brought in from K-Beach Road to the Little League Complex. From there the water will connect into a main distribution center. Water lines will then be run to all 6 baseball/softball fields and 2 practice fields. At least 2 water lines will be run for the restrooms. These fields are not only used by Soldotna Little League who fields an average of 20 youth teams each year, but also the local high schools. Soldotna High School and Skyview High School use these fields for high school baseball and softball. The local American Legion team also uses the Little League Complex. Although the property is leased from the City of Soldotna (currently in the 40th year of a 100 year lease), all improvements are the sole responsibility of Soldotna Little League.

Project Timeline:

The work will start as soon as the ground thaws out, probably mid-May. The project is expected to be completed and fully operational by May 2011. Of course in Alaska, weather delays can occur, but we feel this is a very realistic timeline.
