Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The North Star Imagination Library provides 2,900 Interior Alaska children with a new book in the mail every month at a cost of \$30 per year, per child. With the 50/50 match for state funds provided by the Best Beginnings program, the reach of state dollars is doubled. None of this funding would be spent on program administration - all funds would go directly to providing books for children.
