**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

A new woods stove and stove pipe fixing to decrease the amount of heating oil used during the winter. This will help lower costs to heat the building as needed.

A new boiler is needed in the community center for the health and safety of the children and employees. The current boiler has problems and leaks glycol, which is dangerous to the children. The building has a early head start and head start program with kitchen and our environmental program. The boiler is needed to provide effiecient heat throughout the building and for the health and safety of the children and people.

New washers are need for our washateria. The washers in the washateria are worn and breaking down. Tetlin at this time can not provide effiecient service to the people. The closest community is Tok and they do not have a laundry facility open from September to May.
