Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Funding will repair boardwalk and uplands around the state-owned harbor in Elfin Cove. The community has worked with the Department of Transportation & Public Facilities to advance design and construction of boardwalks to improve the safety of residents and visitors using the harbor. Improvements include widening portions of the boardwalk, adding a ramp to the beach, adding durable non-skid material, handrails, and removal of dilapidated sections, and installation of treated lumber boards.

High rainfall has caused the community boardwalk to become slippery, and with heavy snowloads has damaged many of the handrails and boardwalk. Elfin Cove is a prime charter fishing location and needs to be able to provide safe access to and from the harbor for visitors. The community's economic vitality depends on fishing, and this project will improve the infrastructure necessary to make the community accessible.
