The concern for the community is that should there be a fire in an area with many community residences or apartments the CodeRed unit would not be able to extinguish the fire. The danger to the community and possible damage to the community in terms of housing could be huge and to date Angoon is very lucky they have not had a catastrophic fire.

As soon as funding was aquired immediate searches for a fire truck would be conducted to get a vehicle to the community as soon as possible.


