
Dear Senator Kookesh;

Angoon Senior Center prepared just shy of 7,000 meals to 65 elders this past year. That comes to about 30 meals a day. Household appliances are most often purchased because funds are rarely available for commercial equipment. However, commercial equipment is what is really necessary for us to do a proper job of feeding our elders.

We can buy and have delivered to us a commercial dishwasher and a commercial refrigerator for a total of \$8,000. Right now we are out of compliance with the State DEC because the dishwasher which doesn't work does not sanitize the dishes, putting the seniors at a health risk.

I know you will do everything you can to help us out and please know these are essential pieces of equipment that are much needed.


Dear Senator Kookesh;
