Replace the failing septic system at Ticasuk Brown Elementary School

Ticasuk Brown Elementary School is K-6 school outside the east gate of Fort Wainwright on Lakloey Drive. It was built in 1987 and has an enrollment of about 550 students with 75 full-time and part-time staff members. The school is named after a noted Alaskan native educator, Emily Ivanoff Ticasuk Brown, who did much to preserve the traditional Alaskan native languages and culture in our state.

The school was built in an area with a high groundwater table which takes its toll on septic systems. The septic system has reached the end of its useful life and needs a complete replacement.
