One-Time Need

Brief Project Description:

City is in need of a new ambulance to replace two undependable emergency response vehicles.

Funding Plan:**Total Cost of Project: \$175,000***There is no other funding needed***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Two aging vehicles (1983 & 2002) have been regularly out of service due to mechanical problems with the chassis. This loss leaves Delta Junction Volunteer Rescue Squad with undependable emergency response vehicles. A three year average annual run count is 151 local and 41 transports to Fairbanks Memorial Hospital. This is a revenue source for the City's operations budget.

The City Council is requesting funding for a new vehicle or a chassis remount. The purchase price for a new vehicle delivered to Delta Junction is approximately \$140,000. Additional supplies necessary to equip the new ambulance bring the total request to \$175,000.
