**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Rural Deltana Volunteer Fire Department had an inspection of their facilities conducted last year. Each facility is over 20 years old and are in need of modifications and upgrades. The Big D facility needs foundation insulation, well improvements, a new septic system, french drain closure, UST closures, egress lighting and signage, fire/smoke/freeze protection, emergency power, and the replacement of a large bay door.

The inspector indicated the building was still in "relatively good condition" but the above things needed to be completed to address fire/life/safety, energy efficiency, and environmental concerns that would bring the buildings into better code conformance.

These upgrades and modifications will extend the life of the building, improve energy efficiency, and improve the life safety components of the building.
