**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Major Maintenance Grant Fund - Project #3: Kodiak Schools Seismic Mitigation. This project will provide seismic upgrades districtwide. A Seismic Vulnerability Assessment recommends structural upgrades designed to meet the intent of providing life safety reliability in the event of earthquakes. Non-structural components such as furnaces, heating and ventilation equipment, water tanks, and library bookshelves will also be braced. Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funding of \$1,403,618 that is paid directly to the community, has been considered in the project budget.

Sec.57(j) from 4/18/10 House Floor Amendment # 2 that adds to the Sec.1, Ch.15, SLA 09 allocation. Contingent on passage of SB237 which reduces district participating share to 20% for those with full value per ADM of \$275,001-500,000, thereby increasing state share. Since bill retroactive to projects started by 4/1/08, supplemental funding needed for a few impacted projects.
