Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

This amendment provides funding to do an assessment of the state-owned hatcheries to insure that contractors are in compliance with contractual maintenance terms and also look towards the option/possibility of transfer of ownership if beneficial/acceptable to all parties. This project is important to sustain hatchery production of salmon and contributes to the Department's following End Result - Sustain recreational fishing opportunities while optimizing social and economic benefits from these opportunities.

Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

No prior funding.

Project Description/Justification:

This funding would provide for an engineer's assessment of state-owned hatcheries that are currently contracted out to private operators. The assessment would be directed toward identifying issues such as structural condition, foundation, water lines, mechanical systems, fuel storage facilities etc. that might be in need of repair, out of compliance with current standards and be at risk for failure.

These assessments would be used to determine if the hatcheries are being adequately maintained as required in the contracts with the operators. ADF&G is also interested in transfer of these hatcheries to the operators; having an up to date assessment of condition would be critical for negotiating such a transfer.

There are eleven state-owned hatcheries being operated by private hatchery corporations; the oldest was constructed in 1964, and most were constructed prior to 1980. We know that many have leaks, old mechanical systems, issues with roofs, and various concerns. The department biologists visit these facilities on a regular basis but lack the expertise for a facility inspection and assessment.

There is also concern for considerable financial loss if a roof was to collapse, a pipeline was to fail, or a fuel tank developed a leak. The tenants are responsible and conscientious, but nonetheless we are the owners and bear the bulk of the responsibility for the facility.

This funding can be the first step toward transferring what has become a liability for the state to the private sector where it would be an asset.
