Component: AYK Region Fisheries Management

Contribution to Department's Mission

The Arctic Yukon Kuskokwim (AYK) Region contributes to the department's mission by: 1) ensuring the conservation of natural stocks of fish, shellfish, and aquatic plants based on scientifically sound assessments; 2) sustaining fisheries based on the control and regulation of harvests through responsive management systems; 3) increasing fishery harvests and harvest opportunities of fish, shellfish, and aquatic plants through the investigation of maximum sustained yield for individual and aggregate populations; 4) expanding fishery potential through identification of underutilized species/stocks of fish, shellfish, and aquatic plants; 5) maintaining and enhancing opportunities for public participation in the development of fishery management plans and harvest regulations; 6) developing and maintaining comprehensive databases on commercial, subsistence and personal use harvests, and associated processing of fish, shellfish, and aquatic plants; and 7) promoting public education on the conservation, production, and economic and social benefits of yields from fish, shellfish, and aquatic plants.

Key Component Challenges

The AYK Region Fisheries Management Component is being merged with the Commercial Fisheries Component in FY11. However, the AYK Region continues with the following challenges. Causes for reduced production of Yukon and Norton Sound Chinook salmon are poorly understood. Shifts in marine and freshwater environments may affect productivity across a broad range of salmon stocks.

A challenge for the AYK Region Fisheries Management component stems from recent poor returns of Yukon River Chinook salmon, which are heavily relied upon by the subsistence fishery and provide the majority of value to the commercial fishery. Recent run sizes have been inadequate for significant directed commercial fishing activity and have required strategies to reduce or redirect subsistence harvest to ensure adequate escapements, especially for the Canadian spawning component of the run. The size and complexity of Yukon River salmon harvests make management difficult given the resources and state of methodologies available for run assessment. Additional funding towards new programs or enhancing existing run assessment methodologies may provide more accurate and timely information for making management decisions.

Other component challenges continue to be:

- Complex mixed salmon stock fisheries and harvest management plans are placed under heavy demands by competing user groups, particularly in the Yukon River.
- Since 2000, the Alaska Board of Fisheries has identified Yukon River and eastern Norton Sound Chinook salmon and northern Norton Sound chum salmon stocks as stocks of concern under the Policy for the Management of Sustainable Salmon Fisheries.
- Meeting Yukon River Treaty and Yukon Panel border passage obligations for Chinook salmon given apparent reduction in productivity of this stock.
- Poor market demand and/or capacity limitations for AYK herring, chum salmon, and pink salmon stocks result in continued adjustments of management strategies and increased coordination with the fishing industry to meet competitive market windows and higher product quality requirements.
- Interaction with federal subsistence fishery management and potential impacts to state management, particularly for Yukon River, require continued extensive involvement of regional and area staff and fiscal resources.
- Increasing commercial demand for non-salmon such as whitefish and lamprey has highlighted knowledge gaps for these populations. In the absence of more detailed information, it is difficult to expand these emerging fisheries while ensuring sustainability of these populations.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2011

The AYK Region Fisheries Management Component is being merged into the single Commercial Fisheries Component

in FY11.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2009

- Accurate documentation of commercial harvests, including species, numbers, weight, location, time, gear, and effort; and subsistence harvest estimates are compiled annually and appended to historic data bases.
- Scientifically-based and defensible salmon escapement goals have been, and continue to be, established and refined for many salmon stocks within AYK Region.
- Biological data on fish stocks and age structures are collected, quantified, and reported.
- Management plans in AYK Region, which supports the largest subsistence salmon fisheries in the world, include
 provisions for ensuring a priority for subsistence fishing opportunity, and to allow harvest of surplus fish for
 commercial and personal use purposes.
- AYK Region staff continues to be proactive with the public to develop and initiate cooperative fisheries resource
 assessment programs. AYK Region staff work cooperatively with regional Community Development Quota (CDQ)
 groups and non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and participate on the steering committee associated with the
 AYK Sustainable Salmon Initiative (SSI) federally funded collaborative salmon research program.
- AYK Region is involved in cooperative inseason salmon fisheries management and obtaining input from the public through the Kuskokwim River Salmon Management Working Group and participation in weekly teleconferences conducted by the Yukon River Drainage Fisheries Association.
- AYK Region personnel continue to work cooperatively with industry and the public to improve commercial fisheries
 management to address the declining market value of salmon resources by scheduling fishing periods to meet
 transportation and product quality concerns.
- In 2008, a CIP funded salmon resource inventory of North Slope river drainages was initiated, which has since been shifted to longer term operating funds in state fiscal year 2010. A survey and biological sample collection program has been established, with the expectation for expansion, for pink and chum salmon in several North Slope drainages. Department personnel continue to develop working relationships and coordinate with the North Slope Borough, Department of Wildlife Management, which has been very beneficial to the project. Department personnel have been welcomed into communities to begin the process of collecting traditional ecological knowledge concerning salmon. AYK Region personnel continue to attend public meetings and village residents are very supportive of the project. The public has provided valuable local knowledge regarding salmon usage and spawning locations.
- Small scale commercial whitefish and lamprey fisheries continued in 2009 on the Yukon River in conjunction with the local CDQ group.
- AYK Region management and research personnel participated in the Alaska Board of Fisheries, Federal Subsistence Board/Regional Advisory Council, and U.S./Canada Yukon River Salmon Panel processes. Reports and fisheries data analyses were prepared to address fisheries management and conservation issues.
- Fisheries information was routinely provided to industry, resource users, federal agencies, regional organizations, and the public at large through personal staff contacts, news releases, inseason teleconferencing, distribution of reports, and electronic media. Through coordination with area non-governmental organizations, additional processes were initiated in 2009 to increase public and stakeholder outreach and involvement with Yukon River salmon fisheries management.
