## **Project Description/Justification:**

The alleged violations arose in connection with work initiated by DOT&PF to address damage caused by two 100-year floods that occurred on the Kenai Peninsula in October and November of 2002. DOT&PF restored roadways and public facilities at twelve sites placing bank protection along the Ninilchik, Resurrection, Kenai and Anchor River, and Deep Creek, in alleged violation of the CWA.
