**Project Description/Justification:**

This project consists of the following minor surface improvements at state-owned airports:

1. Additional gravel surfacing.
2. Pavement repair.
3. Brush cutting.
4. Erosion protection improvements.
5. Surface grading and compaction.
6. Painting and pavement marking.
7. Obstruction removal.
8. Other minor surface improvements, as funding allows.

The State maintains approximately 256 Rural System airports. The surfaces on these airports are continuously degrading, due to time, use, settlement, wind and water erosion, moisture accumulation, and vegetation growth. Many of these airports are substandard and need minor surface improvements to improve their safety and capacity. The Department establishes priorities annually for the use of the minor surface improvement funding.
