Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

FY2004 - 4,300,000. This project request has been broken out into regional allocations the past several years.

Project Description/Justification:

The State owns or operates approximately 256 Rural System airports. Some of these airports are highly regulated Part 139 certificated airports. Most State-owned airports have federal funding obligations that create additional management and grant compliance issues including snow removal and aircraft rescue and fire fighting to keep the airports open and safe. These pieces of equipment are necessary to the safe operation of aircraft for the traveling public. The State seeks federal Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funding for Snow Removal Equipment from the Federal Aviation Administration.

This project consists of the following equipment associated with managing, and improving the State's aviation infrastructure.

1. Snow Blower at Dillingham Airport
2. Grader at Nome Airport
3. Self Propelled Blower with Broom and Plow at Sitka Airport
4. Truck with Plow and Sander at Sitka Airport
5. Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting vehicle at Yakutat Airport
6. Loader/Boss Plow with attachments at Chefnak Airport

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7. Grader at False Pass Airport
8. Loader at Kotlik Airport
9. Loader with U-blade at Little Diomedede
10. Grader with attachments at Seward Airport
11. Dozer at Toksook Bay Airport
12. Grader at Tuntutuliak Airport
13. Grader at Kodiak
14. Various airport snow removal and safety equipment yet to be determined
