Project Description/Justification:

Proposed regulations will require AMHS to terminate waste disposal from the vessels while in Washington State waters and it is anticipated that the same will be true for Canadian waters. AMHS ferries are unable to hold sewage for the round-trip transit of Ketchikan to Bellingham. In the future, the only legal way to discharge sewage in Canadian and Washington State waters is through an approved sewage system.
