Reconstruct the runway to community class recommendations plus remove and replace runway lighting, and improve runway surface. Project also includes construction of a new heated Snow Removal Equipment Building (SREB) and rehabilitation of the existing SREB. Project Description/Justification:

The existing 3,000 x 75 foot runway, apron, taxiway, runway lights, and Snow Removal Equipment Building (SREB) have been damaged by differential ground settlement and need to be repaired. This project will remediate existing airport embankments, remove and replace airport lighting, and improve the runway surface. Department maintenance personnel report there is currently no surface material available to properly maintain the runway. Furthermore, there is some substantial settlement under the SREB requiring leveling and improvement to that structure.

The Operating and Maintenance costs are anticipated to increase by approximately \$5,000 per year beginning in FY2012.
