Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

Project Description/Justification:

This section of road has rutting depths nearing .5 inches and an IRI (International Roughness Index) ranging from 136 – 188 and has several rough areas. Ruts filled with water pose a hydroplaning and controllability issue, and this hazard can be exacerbated when ice collects in these ruts. This project will increase safety along this stretch of road and extend the life of the pavement and roadway.
