Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

This is a new FY11 capital request to upgrade the ferry terminal shore-side approach, widening the gangway and removing tight 90 degree turns so that 4-wheelers can approach the float to load/unload cargo from the ferry. This project will also upgrade the float, dolphins, fendering systems and dock surfaces. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing the potential for injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

Project Description/Justification:

For years, the residents of Tenakee Springs have had difficulty getting goods from the ferry to shore. The current gangway is adequate for passengers with small bags but it is too narrow for a 4-wheeled ATV or cart to make it down to the landing (there are no cars in Tenakee Springs, just carts and ATVs). The project will address Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) issues of access. This project will greatly ease the burden of passengers (elders, parents with children, visitors) by making it easier to get their baggage, luggage, freight, parcels, groceries, etc. from the ferry to shore; approximately 400-feet, the first 200-feet being on the gangway. Inclement weather can make this a very difficult journey and requiring multiple trips may delay the ferry from sailing.
