Project Description/Justification:

The Mat-Su Borough (MSB) has experienced high rates of growth, with a 36% increase in population between 2000 and 2007. This growth has outpaced the development of and improvements to the arterial and collector system. The roads listed above are all functionally classified as arterials in the Borough's 2007 Long Range Transportation Plan. They are all projects listed in the 2008 MSB Road Bond Package. This reconnaissance effort will result in well defined project scopes and cost estimates, and will help establish funding priorities.
