Gov request \$1M, Legislature added \$1M. Congressional project from the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2010.

Project Description/Justification:

Many of the rural service area roads are low lying roads that often flood or are severely damaged during high water events. A number of bridges and other drainage structures require improvements. Residents can be cut off from access to the roadway system for days. Emergency crews are unable to reach homes and businesses when life or property is endangered.
