Project to include pedestrian facility from Badger Road to the north side of the Chena River. Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

FY2005 - \$5,700,000; FY2004 - \$1,500,000 for Fort Wainwright Alternative Access.

Project Description/Justification:

This project provides access to a growing residential area with limited access through Fort Wainwright. Security measures imposed since the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001 have further limited access, resulting in conflicts between residents and Fort Wainwright security forces. This project will reduce emergency service response time, improve access to schools and other essential services, and reduce travel times.

Operating and maintenance costs will be approximately \$3,500 per year beginning in 2011.
