# **Component: Anchorage Airport Operations**

### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Ensure a safe, well constructed, well coordinated, environmentally sound operating environment for air carriers and other airport tenants, general aviation, the traveling public, and employees. This section ensures that the airport and its tenants are in compliance with federal, state and airport regulations.

### **Core Services**

- Perform duties required by 14 CFR Part 139 and 49 CFR Part 1542, including daily inspections and surface friction measurements.
- Disseminate Notice to Airmen filings to the Federal Aviation Administration and air carriers.
- Update certification plans.
- Monitor land lease activity and tie down parking for compliance.
- Provide general operational support to air carriers and the general aviation community.
- Provide 24-hour central dispatch radio communications for all airport functions and emergencies.
- Provide prompt and accurate information to air carriers.
- Develop operations plans, monitor air operations activities and recognize, report and resolve aircraft operating problems.

# **Key Component Challenges**

- The Operations Component must prepare for the reconstruction of Runway 7R to minimize effects on air cargo traffic. This will require aggressive coordination of any other runway closures.
- The airport is undertaking the construction of a centralized facility for security, safety, communication and key airport emergency response functions and equipment. Operations must prepare for short term re-location during this Airport Operations Center project.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2011

No significant changes are anticipated at this time.

# **Major Component Accomplishments in 2009**

- Implemented measures to mitigate Mt Redoubt volcano effects. Developed priorities for airport reopening after an
  ash induced closure. Established several communication channels to expedite volcano and airport status to airlines
  and other customers.
- Developed procedures for incorporating all of the fenced in Airport Operation Areas (AOAs) into the Secure Identification Display Area (SIDA).
- Assisted in the development of ANC's tri-annual disaster exercise held in June 2009.
- Closely coordinated and commissioned new Access Control System.
- Commissioned new gate to secure access to taxiway Victor.
