Component Budget Summary

### **Component: Fairbanks Airport Administration**

### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Provide the overall airport management and leadership necessary to assure that all airport functions are conducted in accordance with appropriate laws, regulations, policies, and procedures and in a safe, efficient, and cost-effective manner.

#### **Core Services**

- Plan, organize, direct and control airport functions.
- Develop and implement strategic management plans and airport operating and capital budgets.
- Promote Fairbanks International Airport (FAI) in domestic and international markets through personal outreach, consultant services, printed material, and FAI website.
- Negotiate and administer 212 leases and other agreements.
- Administer airline operating agreements.
- Collect air carrier fees, rents, concession and other revenues.
- Collect and disseminate airport statistical and financial data.
- Maintain local area computer/telephone network backbone and workstations, and provide technical support to subsystems such as maintenance management, Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) environmental hazards database, security badging and automated Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) systems.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

- Global air transport opportunities will continue to change as economic and political conditions change in China, Asia Major, Russia, and central Asia. Marketing staff will concentrate on outreach efforts to attract air carriers to FAI and mitigate the negative effects of global route changes utilizing an extension to a U.S. Department of Transportation Small Community Air Service Development Program grant.
- Staff is continuing efforts to develop and implement competitive offerings for new automated teller machine (ATM) and parking concessions. A new parking lot RFP will be released prior to January 1, 2010, and the new ATM agreement is planned to coincide with spring 2010 expiration of the recently extended agreement.
- Installation of Common Use Passenger Processing System (CUPPS) at ticketing points in the new terminal which will allow multiple air carriers to run their own proprietary ticketing and baggage software from shared common-use equipment.
- Improve the computer network backup and disaster recovery system to meet current Department of Administration (DOA), Enterprise Technology Services (ETS) standards, with which the network is not currently compliant.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2011

No significant changes are anticipated.

### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2009**

- The FY09 winter season saw sustained numbers of Japanese visitors to Fairbanks via direct charter flights with Japan Airlines, bringing 3,732 passengers to view the northern lights and enjoy winter activities.
- Condor Airlines experienced a 3% increase in European visitors to Fairbanks via their direct scheduled service from Frankfurt, Germany compared to the Whitehorse leg of the route that saw a 14% decrease in traffic from last year.
- Extension of the Small Community Air Service Development Grant beyond September 30, 2009 was approved and allows FAI to continue efforts to attract new air carriers in FY10.
- Private leasehold investments in the new terminal worth \$2.6 million that were permitted in FY08 were completed during FY09.
- Executed new agreement for terminal space with associated build out costs to the US General Services Administration on behalf of the Transportation Security Administration (TSA).
- Executed land rent increase adjustments to tenants with existing leases.
- Successfully relocated the commuter air carriers to the new passenger terminal.

- Resolved outstanding issues associated with Block 103 development guidelines and issued a new agreement for the last remaining lot.
- As a service to FAI customers, free WIFI internet service is now available throughout the new passenger terminal.
- Hundreds of telephones lines were upgraded from the traditional public switched telephone network in the old terminal building to "Voice over IP" in the new building, which delivers digitized voice communications via internet lines.
- Internet access was extended to the Emergency Operations Center in the Airport Police and Fire building.
- Demolition of the old passenger terminal prompted the transfer of the Communications Dispatch Center to the Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) building and the replacement of unreliable and outmoded communications equipment with near state-of-the-art radio and digital systems.
