This program funds flooding and glaciation projects throughout Anchorage and is proposed as a 50/50 funding partnership of state grants and local drainage funding. This project is the number one priority for the Public Works Department.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The goal is to improve safety and reduce operation and maintenance costs by addressing flooding and glaciation problem areas. Construction is expected to start in 2012. Some projects being considered for funding include: Autumn Ln, Valley St, Ryoaks Pl, 75th Ave/Margaret Cir, Sylvan Dr, Sperstad Subd, Nunaka Valley, Bancroft Subd, C St at 20th Ave, Briarwood St at 74th Ave, Little Tree Cir/Cindy Lee St Area, Egavik Dr/Denali St Area, Nielsen Way/Bonanza Ave Area, Borland St/Turnagain Blvd Area, 121st Ave at Mary Dr Area, 123rd Ave/Ellen Ave Area, Penland Pkwy, Pine St/4th Ave Area, Furrow Creek culverts, Mars Dr, Oakwood/Burlwood Dr Area, Viburnum Dr, Campbell Woods Subd, and Kachemak Pl.

With input from Street Maintenance, elected officials, community councils, and the public, flooding and glaciation problems throughout the city that present safety and maintenance challenges have been identified. In four of the previous five years, this program has funded more than 50 projects from Girdwood to Eagle River.

Project Timeline:

Construction is expected to start in 2012 on many projects with most expenditures anticipated in 2012 and 2013.
