Brief Project Description:

This project will construct a storm drain extension that connects the 75th Avenue/Margaret Circle area including Papa Circle with the existing storm drain system on 76th Avenue. Full road reconstruction is anticipated as well.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

A design technical memo was done to develop a cost estimate. This project will construct a storm drain extension that connects the 75th Avenue/Margaret Circle area including Papa Circle with the existing storm drain system in 76th Avenue. 75th Avenue is among the most deteriorated roads in the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area (ARDSA). This deterioration is caused by a lack of drainage. This project is a high priority for Street Maintenance and the community council. If the full state grant match is not forthcoming in FY2012, the match could be provided in phases as noted below:

Design/Right of Way/Utilities \$500,000

Construction \$2,500,000

Design expenditures are expected to occur in 2011 and 2012 with construction expense anticipated in 2012 and 2013.

Resolution Number 2011-02

WHEREAS, flooding due to inadequate road drainage is a severe problem on Margaret and Papa Circles, and onto 75th Avenue;

WHEREAS, the lack of proper drainage floods houses every year, causing extensive damage to public and private property;

WHEREAS, flooding leaves Margaret and Papa Circles covered in standing water for weeks at a time;

WHEREAS, many children walk to Campbell Elementary School;

WHEREAS, Margaret Circle serves a school walkway for Campbell Elementary School;

WHEREAS, the drainage problems listed above causes danger and health hazards to children going to and from the school ground;

WHEREAS, 75th Avenue is riddled with frost heaves and pot holes due to improper drainage, which cannot be repaired without major road reconstruction;

WHEREAS, property values are decreasing due to poor drainage, flooding and road conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage public works department has identified Margaret and Papa Circles, and 75th Avenue as Anchorage's worst quality residential streets.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Taku/Campbell Community Council supports funding the 75th Avenue/Margaret Circle Drainage Repair Project as our highest priority state capital request.
