*Funding Details:**In 2010, Elfin Cove was awarded a grant for \$70,000 to repair the boardwalks and uplands around the state-owned harbor in Elfin Cove.***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Project will fund boardwalk and public access repairs in the Community of Elfin Cove. Elfin Cove's economy is based on seasonal tourism and charter fishing. Ensuring safe access around the waterfront and harbor is vital to the community. Funding will cover the design and construction of several improvements including widening portions of the boardwalk, adding ramps for beach access, repairing handrails, removal of dilapidated sections, and installation of treated lumber boards. High rainfall and heavy snowloads have exacerbated decay of the community's aging boardwalk system. These repairs are a top community priority and vital to ensure the town remains accessible for the visitor industry.

Project Timeline:

The current grant award of \$70,000 will be spent on repairs and upgrades during the period FY12-FY13.
